Not every young girl or woman is lucky enough to have a stable family, supportive parents and strong role models. More often than not, the girls who find their way to PACE are currently experiencing or have experienced sexual or physical abuse and depression and anxiety. Most of these girls are just trying to survive from one day to the next. Proper skincare is not even a consideration for most.

PACE helps these girls turn their lives around by providing quality education, counseling, career planning and an opportunity to be successful. PACE helps girls stay in school, reduces their chances of being involved in, or being victims of, crime or violence, and provides hope for girls and their futures. The PACE program has been recognized nationally for its success in breaking the cycle of crime and poverty. PACE has more than a 95% success rate in the first year and more than 85% after five years. This means that 85% of girls who successfully complete the PACE program complete their education (minimum a high school diploma, most go on to vocational school and/or college) and go on to become productive citizens of society.
